Phil attended the Assistive Technology leadership symposium earlier this spring in DC. A keynote speaker Jutta Treviranus, Ph.D. spoke about Equitable Artificial Intelligence. That link has since been removed from the symposium website, but Phil was able to find a <u>similar link from a 2023 talk they gave.</u> The Association of Community Living (ACL) encourages AT programs to partner with emergency response members to improve outcomes around disaster preparedness for persons with disabilities and those with language barriers. While interacting with staff from other AT programs, Phil observed that the VT AT Program staff is rare in that most of our staff have disabilities. We see this as a very positive thing for the community we serve.
