(Joy R.)

Joy is an AT Specialist who covers the state. They work with the AT Program and interface with Money Follow the Person. Age Well Vermont has a new program called CAPABLE. This program looks to address the issue of social isolation in older Vermonters, as well as people transitioning from long term care facilities back to their homes.

Before they transition, relationships are developed with care coordinators so the patient has assistive technology in place when they get home. Capable is striving to keep contacts at long-term facilities, especially during employment turnovers. The project is grant funded for two years. This population includes seniors, as well as adults who are transitioning back home.

Peter mentioned that a core service at VT Center for Independent Living (VCIL), is to advocate for this type of transition. He encouraged anyone in need to reach out to VCIL.

10:30-10:40 ELLIQ (Joy R.)

<u>ElliQ</u> is a care companion robot that encourages social time, exercise, laughing, reminders, and overall to support cognitive and physical wellbeing.

A short video was played which shared a user experience. This type of AT can work for seniors or adults living with or without family.

Another type of AT discussed was the <u>Electronic</u> <u>Caregiver Addison</u>. This equipment is medical in nature and must be referred by a doctor.

Heather mentioned some visual assistance AT:

Envision AI powered eyeglasses.

Aira visual interpreting service.
